

The Strong Families Safe Communities grant has provided a forum for increased collaboration among member agencies and partners. A strong example of the community coming together to collaborate and meet the needs of families is found in our Pause for Parents, Play for Kids respite initiative. Through this volunteer based parent's night out model, families parenting children with complex needs are able to get a break from caregiving on a regular basis, at no cost to them.

Additionally, multiple agencies have come together to participate in a Trauma Learning Community. This six month series will provide in-depth learning about the impacts of trauma and the skills needed to successfully assist individuals impacted by trauma.

The Social Services Resource Expo that premiered in 2013 will be offered for the third year this August. This is another example of how member agencies collaborate to provide improved knowledge of and access to needed services.
